

# Environmental report

In 2010, Legris Industries pursued an ongoing commitment to environmental quality—now an integral part of our sustainable development program. As regulatory constraints in this area increase and customers demand ever more energy-efficient solutions, we aim to have each of our businesses anticipate and benefit from the opportunities that this new issue brings.

## Making sustainable development a Group-wide priority

This year saw the launch of a Group-wide program dedicated to sustainable development. A series of cross-division, cross-functional action plans targeting strategic priorities started up in mid-2010, with staff and contributions from each Division. Priorities defined include reducing the environmental impact of our businesses, especially

manufacturing, and developing a more eco-friendly product offering to meet customer expectations. Action plans developed by working groups will be phased in starting in 2011. Other projects involve adopting key performance indicators and initiatives to raise employees' awareness of the issues at stake.

## Environmental reporting

Changes in the Group's scope of consolidation in recent years included the acquisitions of Ceric in December 2006 and Clextral in March 2007, and the sale of Legris in October 2008. Together these led to the temporary suspension of publication of environmental performance data. But reporting began again in 2010 based on the Group's current structure (Savoie, Clextral and Keller Divisions) and will be gradually expanded as part of our sustainable development program. With no historical trends available for comparison, figures are for information only. Also worth noting: 2010 was a year of particularly slack industrial activity for all Group businesses, with the exception of Clextral.
